## How to Copy Windows Easy Transfer program from Windows 7/8 to Windows 8.1/10

NOTE: Windows 8.1 and 10 does not include the Easy Transfer cable option in Windows Easy Transfer program. The solution would be to copy the Windows Easy Transfer program version from Windows 7 or 8.

Steps	Using Windows 7 or 8 Machine
1	Boot PC to Windows 7 or 8.
	Click <b>Start</b> and enter " <b>Windows Easy Transfer</b> " in search bar. Or Click <b>Start</b> (), click <b>All Programs</b> , click <b>Accessories</b> , click <b>System Tools</b> , click <b>Windows Easy</b> <b>Transfer</b> , and then click <b>Next</b> .
